A RESOLUTION

1 Commending all cosmetologists, nail technicians, estheticians, barbers, and other
2 cosmetology related providers and acknowledging February 10, 2003, and henceforth
3 annually as "Cosmetology and Barber's Day in Georgia"; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is served daily by the thousands of cosmetologists, nail
5 technicians, estheticians, barbers, and other cosmetology related providers who have
6 dedicated themselves to the upkeep of our personal well-being and appearance; and

7 WHEREAS, it is largely upon their courage and commitment that our fundamental
8 appearance and well-being are built and secured; and

9 WHEREAS, in rendering essential public services professionally and selflessly, this state's
10 cosmetologists and barbers help to assure an orderly appearance and enhance the citizenry's
11 sense of health and esteem; and

12 WHEREAS, in placing the well-being and appearance of society above their personal
13 concerns and, in some instances, risking their own health for the sake of others, the
14 cosmetology providers in this state exemplify the highest nobility and greatest commitment
15 to health and beauty aide ideals; and;

16 WHEREAS, it is most fitting and proper that the commitment and contributions of the
17 cosmetologists, nail technicians, estheticians, barbers, and other cosmetology related
18 providers be duly recognized and commended annually.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 express their profound gratitude to all the cosmetologists, nail technicians, estheticians,
21 barbers, and other cosmetology related providers within the State of Georgia and proudly
22 acknowledge February 10, 2003, and henceforth annually as "Cosmetology and Barber's Day
