A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	current use assessment for ad valorem taxation of bona fide conservation use property, so as
3	to include undeveloped riverside or streamside lands within buffer zones established by law
4	or local ordinance as eligible for such assessment; to provide for an effective date and
5	applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Code Section 48-5-7.4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to current use
9	assessment for ad valorem taxation of bona fide conservation use property, is amended by
10	striking subparagraph (a)(2)(F) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
11	"(F) River or stream corridors or buffers which shall be defined as those undeveloped
12	lands adjacent <u>which are:</u>
13	(i) Adjacent to rivers and perennial streams that are within the 100 year flood plain
14	as depicted on official maps prepared by the Federal Emergency Management
15	Agency <u>; or</u>
16	(ii) Within buffer zones adjacent to rivers or perennial streams, which buffer zones
17	are established by law or local ordinance and within which land-disturbing activity
18	is prohibited."
19	SECTION 2.
20	This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2004, and shall apply to all taxable years
21	beginning on or after such date.
22	SECTION 3.
23	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
