A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 3-2-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the 2 powers and duties of special agents and enforcement officers of the Department of Revenue, 3 so as to provide that certain special agents and enforcement officers of said department who 4 leave such department as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty may retain their 5 weapons and badges upon leaving the department; to amend Code Section 27-1-16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the establishment of a unit of conservation 6 7 rangers within the Department of Natural Resources, so as to provide that certain 8 conservation rangers of said department who leave such department as a result of a disability 9 arising in the line of duty may retain their weapons and badges upon leaving the department; 10 to amend Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to provide that certain members of the Uniform Division who 11 12 leave such division as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty may retain their 13 weapons and badges upon leaving the division; to provide that when an agent of the Georgia 14 Bureau of Investigation leaves the bureau under honorable conditions and after accumulating 15 25 years of law enforcement service with the bureau or as a result of a disability arising in 16 the line of duty, such agent shall be entitled as part of such agent's compensation to retain 17 his or her weapon and badge pursuant to regulations promulgated by the director of investigation; to amend Code Section 48-11-19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 18 19 relating to the powers and duties of special agents and enforcement officers of the 20 Department of Revenue, so as to provide that certain special agents and enforcement officers 21 of said department who leave such department as a result of a disability arising in the line of 22 duty may retain their weapons and badges upon leaving the department; to repeal conflicting 23 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

2 Code Section 3-2-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the powers and

- 3 duties of special agents and enforcement officers of the Department of Revenue, is amended
- 4 by striking subsection (d) and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 "(d) After an agent or enforcement officer has accumulated 25 years of service with the
- 7 department, upon leaving the department under honorable conditions When an agent or
- 8 <u>enforcement officer leaves the department under honorable conditions and after</u>
- 9 accumulating 25 years of service with the department or as a result of a disability arising
- in the line of duty, such agent or enforcement officer shall be entitled as part of such
- officer's compensation to retain his or her weapon and badge pursuant to regulations
- promulgated by the commissioner."

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 Code Section 27-1-16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 15 establishment of a unit of conservation rangers within the Department of Natural Resources,
- 16 is amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (b) to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 "(b) After a conservation ranger has accumulated 25 years of service with the department
- as a peace officer and upon leaving such department under honorable conditions When
- 20 <u>a conservation ranger leaves the department under honorable conditions and after</u>
- 21 <u>accumulating 25 years of service with the department or as a result of a disability arising</u>
- in the line of duty, such conservation ranger shall be entitled as part of his or her
- compensation to retain his <u>or her</u> weapon and badge pursuant to regulations promulgated
- by the commissioner."
- 25 SECTION 3.
- 26 Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to law enforcement officers and
- agencies, is amended by striking Code Section 35-2-49, relating to the provision of proper
- 28 uniforms and equipment to members of the Uniform Division of the Department of Public
- 29 Safety, and inserting in lieu thereof a new Code Section 35-2-49 to read as follows:
- 30 "35-2-49.
- 31 The commissioner shall, within the limit of the appropriation, provide the members of the
- Uniform Division of the Department of Public Safety with proper uniforms, suitable to the
- season, and also with emergency and first-aid outfits, weapons, motor vehicles with radio
- equipment, and all other necessary supplies and equipment for the purpose of carrying out
- 35 this article, the same to remain the property of the state; provided, however, that after a

member has accumulated 25 years of service in the Uniform Division of the Department of Public Safety, upon leaving the division under honorable conditions when a member leaves the Uniform Division under honorable conditions and after accumulating 25 years of service with the Uniform Division or as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty, such member shall be entitled, as part of his or her compensation, to retain his or her weapon and badge pursuant to regulations promulgated by the commissioner. The commissioner shall also, within the limit of the appropriation, provide proper uniforms and equipment to radio operators. After a radio operator has accumulated 25 years of service with the department, upon leaving the department under honorable conditions, such radio operator shall be entitled, as part of his or her compensation, to retain his or her badge pursuant to regulations promulgated by the commissioner."

12 SECTION 4.

Said title is further amended by adding at the end of Code Section 35-3-11, relating to the applicability to agents of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation of rules of the State Personnel Board and state merit system, a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) When an agent of the bureau leaves the bureau under honorable conditions and after accumulating 25 years of law enforcement service with the bureau or as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty, such agent shall be entitled as part of such agent's compensation to retain his or her weapon and badge pursuant to regulations promulgated by the director."

21 SECTION 5.

Code Section 48-11-19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the powers and duties of special agents and enforcement officers of the Department of Revenue, is amended by striking subsection (c) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) After a special agent or enforcement officer has accumulated 25 years of service with the department, upon leaving the department under honorable conditions When a special agent or enforcement officer leaves the department under honorable conditions and after accumulating 25 years of service with the department or as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty, such special agent or enforcement officer shall be entitled as part of such agent's or officer's compensation to retain his or her weapon and badge pursuant to regulations promulgated by the commissioner."

1 SECTION 6.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
