## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing deep regret at the passing of Ellen Gilreath Carmack; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on January 22, 2003, the State of Georgia lost one of its most exemplary and  
3 beloved citizens with the untimely passing of Ellen Gilreath Carmack; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she was a long-time resident of Gwinnett County and a teacher in the Gwinnett  
5 County schools, having graduated from Central Gwinnett High School in 1988, and North  
6 Georgia College in 1992; and
- 7 WHEREAS, for three years she served as the liaison coordinator for the moral and civic  
8 concerns ministry of Hebron Baptist Church in Dacula where she could always be counted  
9 on to make calls and write letters on important moral issues; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this outstanding Christian woman believed it was important to vote in every  
11 election and would do so by absentee ballot when she was not physically able to get to the  
12 polls; and
- 13 WHEREAS, she was a devoted and loving wife to her husband, John, and a dedicated and  
14 loving mother to her son, Jacob; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, kind, and respected lady leaves a void  
16 in the hearts and lives of her family and friends.

18 express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Ellen Gilreath Carmack.
