

House Bill 319

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 19-11-9.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 duty to furnish information about obligor to department, use of information obtained, and  
3 penalty for noncompliance, so as to provide for the acceptance of a certification of  
4 noneligibility for issuance of a social security number by the Department of Motor Vehicle  
5 Safety; to amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia  
6 Annotated, relating to issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers' licenses, so as to provide  
7 for other information to be included in an application for a driver's license; to provide for  
8 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

10 Code Section 19-11-9.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the duty to  
11 furnish information about obligor to department, use of information obtained, and penalty  
12 for noncompliance, is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a.1) of said Code  
13 section and inserting in its place the following:

15 "(a.1)(1) In accordance with the mandate contained in 42 U.S.C. Section 666(a)(13)(A)  
16 and notwithstanding any provision of Title 40 relating to motor vehicles as now existing  
17 or hereafter amended, the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety shall require an applicant  
18 for a driver's license, a commercial driver's license, a learner's permit, or an identification  
19 card to provide to the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety the applicant's social security  
20 number or certification from the Social Security Administration that the applicant is not  
21 eligible for issuance of a social security number as part of the application. The Department  
22 of Motor Vehicle Safety shall provide to the Department of Human Resources, in addition  
23 to other information required to be provided to the Department of Human Resources, such  
24 social security numbers of individuals who have been issued a driver's license, a  
25 commercial driver's license, a learner's permit, or an identification card. The Department  
26 of Human Resources shall use the information provided by the Department of Motor

1 Vehicle Safety pursuant to this Code section for the purpose of complying with the  
2 requirements of law concerning the enforcement of child support.”

3 **SECTION 2.**

4 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
5 issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers’ licenses, is amended by striking subsection (c)  
6 of Code Section 40-5-25, relating to application and fees for drivers’ licenses, and inserting  
7 in its place the following:

8 “(c) Every such application shall state the full name, date of birth, sex, and residence  
9 address of the applicant; shall briefly describe the applicant; and shall state whether the  
10 applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver and, if so, when and by what state or  
11 country, and whether any such license has ever been suspended, revoked, or refused, and,  
12 if so, the date of and reason for such suspension, revocation, or refusal; and shall state such  
13 other information as the commissioner may require to determine the applicant’s identity,  
14 competence, and eligibility. The application shall include any other information as required  
15 by paragraph (1) of subsection (a.1) of Code Section 19-11-9.1. The department shall not  
16 issue a license until a complete examination of the applicant’s record has been completed.  
17 The commissioner may issue such rules and regulations as shall be necessary for the  
18 orderly processing of license applications.”

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
