A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Janie Mae Fields Wright and expressing sympathy at her passing; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Janie Mae Fields Wright was a native of Cooswhatchie, S.C., who spent most
4 of her life in Savannah, Georgia, where she was loved and valued as a friend and neighbor;

6 WHEREAS, she expressed her love and concern for her fellow citizens through her active
7 involvement with her beloved church, the Second Arnold Baptist Church; and

8 WHEREAS, she served the church as President of the Senior Choir, the Senior Mission, the
9 BTU, and the Sunday School and as a member of the combined choirs, advisor for the
10 Bolden Mission, and the Deacon and Deacon Wives Ministry; and

11 WHEREAS, she could often be found working the church's kitchen preparing food to feed
12 the homeless; and

13 WHEREAS, she was known throughout the City of Savannah for her humorous inspirational
14 readings; and

15 WHEREAS, she was the widow of the Deacon Leroy B. Wright, Sr., the mother of three sons
16 and three daughters and a beloved grandmother and great-grandmother; and

17 WHEREAS, hers was a generous, kind spirit that enriched the life of her family and
18 community and which will be remembered lovingly always.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 honor the life of Janie Mae Fields Wright, recognize her as an outstanding citizen of the State
21 of Georgia, and express sincerest sympathy at her passing.
