A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Byrd M. Bruce and designating the Byrd M. Bruce Interchange; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Byrd M. Bruce has long been recognized by the citizens of the City of Jefferson
4 and Hall County for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal
5 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of this state; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his state as evidenced dramatically by his 28
8 years of superlative service as city councilman and mayor; and

9 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
10 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of his
11 community have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

12 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
13 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
15 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 GEORGIA that the members of this body commend Byrd M. Bruce for his almost three
18 decades of efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the citizens of his
19 community and state.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the intersection of Interstate 85 and U.S. Highway 129
21 in the City of Jefferson be designated the Byrd M. Bruce Interchange.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
2 directed to place and maintain appropriate markers designating the Byrd M. Bruce
3 Interchange.

5 transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Byrd M. Bruce.
