A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Perry High School Future Farmers of America; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Perry High School Future Farmers of America (FFA) brought considerable
3 fame and honor to the State of Georgia and to the school, student body, and community as
4 three of its students were named the 2002 national winners of the FFA Floriculture
5 competition; and

6 WHEREAS, in the National FFA Floriculture Career Development Event, students test their
7 knowledge of the floriculture industry and skills in the cultivation of flowers, plants, and
8 foliage; and Katie Wilson won 1st place individual in the nation; Ashley Whiddon won 2nd
9 place individual in the nation; and Ashley Seamon won 27th place individual in the nation;

11 WHEREAS, Argene Claxton, Perry High School advisor, prepared them for region, state,
12 and national competitions and Perry High FFA students have competed at the national level
13 each year since 1988 and the school has had national winners for the past two years; and

14 WHEREAS, the team won first place at local and state levels and earned the privilege of
15 representing Georgia at the 75th National FFA Convention held in Louisville, Kentucky,
16 where these three students superbly demonstrated their knowledge in real-life situations.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 recognize and congratulate the Perry High School FFA national winners: Katie Wilson,
19 Ashley Whiddon, and Ashley Seamon and their dedicated advisor Argene Claxton on their
20 high honor.
