A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for apportionment of the House
- 2 of Representatives on the basis of single-member districts; to provide for the submission of
- 3 this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article III, Section II, Paragraph I of the Constitution is amended by striking subparagraph
- 7 (b) and inserting in its place a new subparagraph (b) to read as follows:
- 8 "(b) The House of Representatives shall consist of not fewer than 180 Representatives
- 9 apportioned among representative, each of whom shall be elected from single-member
- districts of the state."

11 SECTION 2.

- 12 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 14 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 15 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to provide for apportionment of the
- 16 () NO House of Representatives on the basis of single-member districts?"
- 17 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 18 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 19 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 20 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
