3 who served as the very capable and dedicated Tax Commissioner of Chattooga County; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he had been the county tax commissioner for the past 22 years and had an  
5 outstanding reputation for administering the complex duties of his office with the utmost  
6 ability and adhering strictly to the principles of equity, economy, and efficiency; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he maintained a sound financial organization for Chattooga County as the  
8 population expanded with business and industrial development and the tax digest changed;

16 father to two fine sons, Donnie and John, and to two dear daughters, Carol and Brandi.

18 the members of this body express regret at the passing of Hugh Don Hall and convey their
