A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Muscogee County School District mentoring program "ON TRACK" and
2 inviting representatives of the program, schools, and mentor organizations to appear before
3 the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Muscogee County School District established a mentoring program for
5 children ages eight through 12 to assist young students to stay on track and succeed; and

6 WHEREAS, "ON TRACK" is an acronym for organizing, nurturing, team building,
7 respecting, achieving, character building, and knowledge which are program objectives; and

8 WHEREAS, members of the Gamma Tau Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority,
9 Inc., in collaboration with the Muscogee County School District Office of Volunteer Service
10 serve as mentors at J. D. Davis Elementary School and Dimon Magnet Academy; and

11 WHEREAS, the "ON TRACK" mentoring program provides creativity and discovery in and
12 outside the classroom and includes many cultural, physical, and social opportunities which
13 help build positive self-esteem in students, improve academic grades and test scores, and
14 eventually lead to well-rounded and more productive citizens.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body commend the mentoring program "ON TRACK" and invite
17 representatives from the Muscogee County School District, the Gamma Tau Omega Chapter
18 of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., and the participating schools to appear before this body
19 at a time to be determined by the Speaker of the House.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
21 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Muscogee County
22 School District Office of Volunteer Service.
