10 Membership and Member Services Committee, and the Academy honored him as Family  
11 Physician of the Year; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he and his wife, Anne Paul McGahee, reared a fine family of two sons and two  
13 daughters, and they delighted in their two grandsons and three granddaughters; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he always had a smile and a hug for everyone, and it was a rare occasion when  
15 he didn't have a joke; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he passed from this life on January 1, 2003, and will be sorely missed.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body honor the memory of Dr. Ollie O. McGahee, Jr., as a family  
19 physician that exemplified the highest ideals of the practice of medicine.
