A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 47-2-292 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 membership in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia by tax commissioners and
- 3 receivers and their employees, contributions, and credit for prior service, so as to change the
- 4 time during which such employees may exercise the option for such membership; to provide
- 5 for creditable service for certain prior service; to provide for the payment of employer and
- 6 employee contributions; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal; to
- 7 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Code Section 47-2-292 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to membership
- in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia by tax commissioners and receivers and
- 12 their employees, contributions, and credit for prior service, is amended by inserting at the end
- 13 thereof the following:

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- 14 "(i) Any person who is an employee of a tax commissioner, tax collector, or tax receiver
- on July 1, 2004, and who was eligible pursuant to the provisions of subsection (g) of this
- 16 Code section to elect membership in this retirement system but who failed to do so shall
- have the option, which must be exercised on or before December 31, 2004, of becoming
- a member of the retirement system under the provisions of Code Section 47-2-334. Such
- 20 under the retirement system for actual previous service as an employee of a tax

employees electing membership in the retirement system may obtain creditable service

- commissioner, tax collector, or tax receiver by paying to the board of trustees the regular
- employer and employee contributions for each year or portion thereof claimed as previous
- service, with the computation of such contributions being based on the compensation of the
- employee at the time the service was rendered. In addition to such employer and employee
- contributions, the employee claiming such previous service shall pay interest at the rate of
- 6 percent per annum on the amount of such contributions compounded annually from the

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1 time the previous service was rendered until payment is made to the board of trustees. The

- 2 payment required for such previous service shall be made to the board of trustees at the
- 3 time application is made for membership in the retirement system. Except for the right to
- 4 obtain creditable service for previous service as provided in this subsection, any person
- 5 employed on June 30, 1983, who elects membership in the retirement system shall be under
- 6 the provisions of Code Section 47-2-334."

7 SECTION 2.

- 8 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2004, only if it is determined to have been
- 9 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 10 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2004, as
- required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

SECTION 3.

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
