2 WHEREAS, Officer James M. Weinmann has served with honor and distinction as a member
3 of the East Point Police Department and is an honest and dedicated public servant who
4 strives for excellence in all his endeavors and whose primary concern is the welfare and
5 safety of the citizens of East Point; and

7 government officials as a man of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the administration

14 on behalf of the citizens of this state.

16 the members of this body unanimously commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless
17 dedication exhibited by Officer James M. Weinmann in carrying out the difficult duties of
18 his vocation for the past two years and extend to him their best wishes for a speedy recovery
19 and their utmost appreciation for having so purely and truly defined for others the meaning
20 of public servant.
