A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Warwick as the Grits Capital of Georgia and commending and recommending
2 the Warwick Grits Festival; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the City of Warwick is universally recognized as the Grits Capital of Georgia,
4 and Georgia is by popular acclaim the Grits Capital of the World, so common logic places
5 Warwick dead in the center of the universe, grits wise; and

6 WHEREAS, the City of Warwick and the Warwick-Lake Blackshire Business Association
7 are jointly sponsoring the annual Grits Festival on April 12, 2003, and the event will
8 undoubtedly be attended by persons of high and low estate from around the world, all
9 mingling to pay homage to The Grit and to sample the results of the Great Grits Cook-Off
10 held during the festival and perhaps steal away with such recipes as Earline Smith's
