#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Nancy C. Kennedy; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Ms. Nancy C. Kennedy is one of the most distinguished professional educators  
3 in the State of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Ms. Kennedy received a BA from the Woman's College of Georgia in 1967 and  
5 a Master's Degree in English and History from Georgia College in 1973; and
- 6 WHEREAS, during an exemplary career in education she has compiled 34 total years of  
7 teaching experience, including 28 years at Georgia Military College; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Ms. Kennedy has been recognized on four occasions as the Star Teacher of the  
9 Year at her school and has also been selected on one occasion as Teacher of the Year; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she has been a leader in extracurricular activities as well as academics,  
11 including service in coaching, receiving the Coach of the Year in Tennis Award, as literary  
12 coordinator, and as Debate Team Coach; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Wednesday, February 12, 2003, is Georgia Military College Day at the Capitol  
14 and Ms. Kennedy was instrumental in organizing this annual event some 20 years ago,  
15 making this a particularly auspicious time for the Senate to express its appreciation to  
16 Ms. Kennedy.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body hereby  
18 recognizes and commends Nancy C. Kennedy for her outstanding career in education and her  
19 many important contributions to the State of Georgia and the young people who are the  
20 state's most precious asset.
