A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 6 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sexual
2 offenses, so as to change certain provisions relating to pimping; to repeal conflicting laws;
3 and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Chapter 6 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sexual offenses,
7 is amended by striking Code Section 16-6-11, relating to pimping, and inserting in lieu
8 thereof the following:

9 "16-6-11.

10 A person commits the offense of pimping when he performs any of the following acts:

- 11 (1) Offers or agrees to procure a prostitute for another;
- 12 (2) Offers or agrees to arrange a meeting of persons for the purpose of prostitution;
- 13 (3) Directs or transports another to a place knowing or having a reasonable cause to
14 believe that such direction or transportation is for the purpose of prostitution;
- 15 (4) Receives money or other thing of value from a prostitute, without lawful
16 consideration, knowing it was earned in whole or in part from prostitution; or
- 17 (5) Aids or abets, counsels, or commands another in the commission of prostitution or
18 aids or assists in prostitution where the proceeds or profits derived therefrom are to be
19 divided on a pro rata basis."

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
