A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing 4-H Day at the state capitol and Cole Ryles, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles, and Dr.
2 Gale A. Buchanan; and for other purposes.

4 years of age to learn valuable lessons outside the classroom and offers some 55 areas in
5 which students can compete with one another for college scholarships; and

7 of the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and this
8 service is the major university outreach program focusing on the youth of this state; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles of the Cooperative Extension Service has worked
12 diligently with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia during his tenure as State 4-H Club leader;

15 of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences of the University of Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, 4-H day at the state capitol is a way for the State of Georgia to recognize the
