A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Assistant Special Agent in Charge Janet R. Oliva as the Peace Officer of the
2 Year for Meritorious Service and inviting her to appear before the House of Representatives;
3 and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Assistant Special Agent in Charge Janet R. Oliva of the Georgia Bureau of
5 Investigation was selected by the Peace Officers' Association of Georgia as Officer of the
6 Year for Meritorious Service; and

7 WHEREAS, she has a long and distinguished record of service with the Georgia Bureau of
8 Investigation, having begun her career on August 1, 1986, as a narcotics agent; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1995 she assumed the position of Child Abuse Coordinator and is regularly
10 involved with the Georgia Child Abuse Prevention Panel; and

11 WHEREAS, the Child Abuse Investigative Support Center was established on August 16,
12 2000, largely due to her efforts, and since its inception the center, lead by ASAC Oliva, has
13 trained more than 1,000 law enforcement officers, caseworkers, and coroners regarding
14 investigations of child abuse and child fatality; and

15 WHEREAS, her determination and character have been reflected in her professional
16 performance throughout her career with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, and her high
17 standards of conduct have served as a model for subordinates and peers who share deep
18 admiration for this fine agent; and

19 WHEREAS, the extraordinary commitment of ASAC Oliva to manage her responsibilities
20 completely and with exemplary demeanor has inspired others to follow her outstanding
21 example of courage in all facets of life.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body recognize and commend Assistant Special Agent in Charge
3 Janet R. Oliva as the recipient of the Peace Officers' Association of Georgia 2002 Peace
4 Officer of the Year Award for Meritorious Service and invite her to appear before the House
5 of Representatives at a time to be determined by the Speaker of the House of
6 Representatives.
