

House Bill 103 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to retirement and
2 pensions, so as to correct typographical, stylistic, and other errors and omissions in Title 47
3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and in Acts of the General Assembly amending
4 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to correct capitalization and spelling in
5 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to provide for other matters relative to
6 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to provide an effective date; to repeal
7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to retirement and pensions, is
11 amended as follows:

12 (1) By striking "prekindergarten" and inserting in its place "pre-kindergarten" in
13 paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section 47-3-127.1, relating to employment of a
14 retired teacher as a full-time teacher, the period of employment being limited, and automatic
15 termination.

16 (2) By striking "\$2.00" and inserting in its place "Two dollars" and by inserting "fee" after
17 "filing" in subparagraph (a)(1)(B) and by striking "\$1.00" and inserting in its place "One
18 dollar" in subparagraph (a)(1)(C) of Code Section 47-11-50, relating to the payment to the
19 probate judges retirement fund of a portion of fees collected in connection with marriage
20 licenses, duty to record and report collection, interest, delinquent payment, and penalties.

21 (3) By striking "actuaries" and inserting in its place "actuary" in subsection (e) of Code
22 Section 47-24-22, relating to the administration and operation of the Georgia Military
23 Pension Fund.

24 (4) By striking "moneys loaned or borrowed from the board" and inserting in its place
25 "moneys loaned by or borrowed from the fund" in subsection (b) of Code Section 47-24-23,
26 relating to the trustees of funds, the power to invest funds, conflicts of interest as to

1 investments, custody of funds, and vouchers regarding the administration and management
2 of the Georgia Military Pension Fund.
3 (5) By striking "Guard, and" and inserting in its place "Guard, or" in Code Section 47-24-81,
4 relating to transfer of service credits regarding the administration and management of the
5 Georgia Military Pension Fund.

6 **SECTION 2.**

7 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
8 without such approval.

9 **SECTION 3.**

10 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
