AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 29 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions concerning guardians, so as to provide certain immunities from liability
- 3 for persons serving as guardians ad litem; to provide for related matters; to provide an
- 4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 29 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions concerning guardians, is amended by adding a new Code Section 29-1-3 to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 "29-1-3.
- No person appointed by any court in this state to serve as a guardian ad litem shall be liable
- for damages resulting from any act or failure to act by such person in the performance of
- such person's duties as a guardian ad litem unless such act or failure to act constituted
- gross negligence or reckless, wanton, or intentional misconduct."
- 15 SECTION 2.
- 16 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 17 without such approval.
- 18 SECTION 3.
- 19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
