A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Brunswick Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Brunswick Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution was
4 organized on February 12, 1903, to coincide with the day General James Oglethorpe made
5 his historic landing at Yamacraw Bluff in 1733; and

6 WHEREAS, the chapter has placed numerous historical markers on Revolutionary War
7 soldiers' and patriots' graves and other sites of historical interest; and

8 WHEREAS, the chapter sponsors many historical and patriotic essay contests and awards
9 medals, pins, certificates and scholarships to outstanding students; and

10 WHEREAS, on February 13, 2003, the chapter will celebrate the grand event of the
11 centennial anniversary of its founding.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
13 commend the Brunswick Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution for its many
14 magnificent contributions to the state, recognize the chapter for ten decades of superlative
15 service on behalf of the citizens of Georgia, and congratulate the chapter on the occasion of
16 its 100th anniversary.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
18 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Brunswick Chapter of the Daughters
