A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 34-8-182 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 authority to collect an administrative assessment and to deposit the funds in a clearing
3 account, so as to provide for the allocation of such funds; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 34-8-182 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the authority
8 to collect an administrative assessment and to deposit the funds in a clearing account, is
9 amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the
10 following:

11 "34-8-182.

12 (a) The Commissioner is authorized to collect the administrative assessment as provided
13 in Code Section 34-8-180 and to deposit the funds in the clearing account of the
14 Unemployment Compensation Fund created by Code Section 34-8-83; provided, however,
15 that only one-half of such funds shall ~~not~~ be considered as part of the Unemployment
16 Compensation Fund and shall ~~not~~ be deposited with the secretary of the treasury of the
17 United States. The Commissioner is further authorized to transfer one-half of the funds
18 from that account to the state treasury.

19 (b) The General Assembly is authorized to appropriate to the department all funds
20 collected and deposited in the state treasury under this article. These funds shall be payable
21 upon requisition of the Commissioner."

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
