A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the City of Buchanan on its new City Hall; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on January 24, 2003, more than 100 residents from all over Haralson County
3 joined the officials and employees of the City of Buchanan to celebrate the grand opening
4 of the city's new municipal building; and

5 WHEREAS, among the guests who participated in the official ribbon cutting, reception, and
6 tour were representatives from county government, the cities of Tallapoosa and Temple, the
7 Chamber of Commerce, the Haralson County Development Authority, and the area police,
8 sheriff, fire, and emergency service departments plus many Buchanan residents; and

9 WHEREAS, Honorable Charles Carter, the former councilman who served for over 30 years,
10 was given the honor of cutting the ribbon since he was the driving force behind the building
11 of this marvelous new City Hall; and

12 WHEREAS, this spacious municipal building is prominently located across the street from
13 the post office and generously includes the various administrative offices of city government
14 plus offices for the mayor, councilmembers, and city clerks, a public meeting room, and the
15 Buchanan police station with its unique space needs.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 congratulate the City of Buchanan and its fine residents on their new City Hall and convey
18 their best wishes to the various local officials who deserve this much needed new facility.
