### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Ms. Anslie Garner Philpot; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Ms. Anslie Garner Philpot was selected as Rockmart's Artist of the Year 2003  
3 and will be honored at a party on February 22, 2003; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she has had a God-given talent for creativity all of her life, and her earliest  
5 memories are of drawing stories before she could read and write; and
- 6 WHEREAS, her parents encouraged her talent, making sure she always had the raw material  
7 she needed to pursue her inclination for drawing and carving; and
- 8 WHEREAS, as a young mother, she drew pictures and created puppets to entertain her three  
9 young children, each of whom carried the creativity learned at their mother's knee into their  
10 careers; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in 1974, Ms. Barbara Makar, author of the Primary Phonics series of books, saw  
12 some of Ms. Philpot's work and engaged her to illustrate her books; and
- 13 WHEREAS, she has long been active in the Girl Scouts of America as Service Unit Director  
14 and Leader for her daughter's troop, then as a freelance artist for the Girl Scout Council of  
15 Northwest Georgia, and she proposed, designed, and illustrated her own book, My Own  
16 Daisy Book, as a handbook for the youngest Daisy Scouts; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she has received numerous awards and recognitions for her prodigious talent  
18 and her propensity to use her abilities to benefit others.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 commend Ms. Anslie Garner Philpot for her talent and her accomplishments.
