A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Wayne County 4-H (Senior) Archery Team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Wayne County 4-H (Senior) Archery Team is the Gold Medalist and
3 National Champion of the 2002 National 4-H Invitational Shooting Match held in Raton,
4 New Mexico, finishing first in the F.I.T.A. competition, second in field archery, and first in
5 3-D archery, bringing honor to themselves, their community, and this state; and
- 6 WHEREAS, these 4-H members have demonstrated extreme dedication, hard work, personal
7 sacrifice, and perseverance to achieve these honors and this distinction; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Coach Gary Frye has proven to be an exceptional coach and teacher in the
9 development and leadership of this archery team; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the parents and citizens of Wayne County are greatly appreciative of the
11 accomplishments of these young people and their coach; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the spirit of competition and pride in success has been reinforced by the shining
13 example set by the Wayne County 4-H (Senior) Archery Team; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this team not only excelled in 2002, but also earned the recognition of Gold
15 Medalist and National Champion in 2001 in San Antonio, Texas, finished fourth in the 2000
16 competition, and were crowned Georgia State Champion in 2000; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in addition to all their hard work and practice, the team financed their travel and
18 lodging by picking up trash on the shoulders of the highways, sponsoring a mechanical bull
19 at various community functions, yard sales, car washes, and an archery shooting gallery.

21 commend the efforts of the Wayne County 4-H (Senior) Archery Team.
