A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Officer Stewart Cronin; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Officer Stewart Cronin of the Macon Police Department has recently been
3 recognized by the Peace Officers Association of Georgia as co-winner of the POAG - Officer
4 of the Year - Valor Award; and
- 5 WHEREAS, on December 18, 2001, Officer Cronin displayed selfless courage and heroism
6 in responding to a domestic violence call and preventing a tragedy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the suspect in this case was holding a gun to his wife's head and threatening to
8 kill her; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Officer Cronin was ultimately forced to fire upon and wound the suspect in
10 order to save the life of the suspect's wife and Officer Cronin acted with great
11 professionalism and bravery in a most dangerous situation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the heroic actions of Officer Cronin on this occasion exemplify the highest
13 standards of the law enforcement profession and should be recognized by this body.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body hereby
15 recognizes and commends Officer Stewart Cronin for his outstanding service to the State of
16 Georgia and its citizens and expresses its gratitude to him.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate shall transmit an appropriate
18 copy of this resolution to Officer Cronin.
