A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Assistant Special Agent in Charge Janet R. Oliva; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Assistant Special Agent in Charge Janet R. Oliva of the Georgia Bureau of
4 Investigation has recently been recognized by the Peace Officers Association of Georgia as
5 winner of the POAG - Officer of the Year - Meritorious Service Award; and

6 WHEREAS, ASAC Oliva is the supervisor of the Child Abuse Investigative Support Center
7 and coordinates the efforts of the GBI Investigative Division and the Medical Examiner's
8 office concerning violent crimes against children; and

9 WHEREAS, the Child Abuse Investigative Support Center was established on August 16,
10 2000, due in large part to the efforts of ASAC Oliva; and

11 WHEREAS, since its inception the Center has trained more than 1,000 law enforcement
12 officers, caseworkers, and coroners regarding investigations of child abuse and child
13 fatalities and has conducted numerous forensic consultations and criminal investigative
14 analyses; and

15 WHEREAS, ASAC Oliva has displayed great professionalism and dedication in improving
16 her own abilities and this state's law enforcement capabilities in her most important area of
17 expertise.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body hereby
19 recognizes and commends Assistant Special Agent in Charge Janet R. Oliva for her
20 outstanding service to the State of Georgia and its citizens and expresses its gratitude to her.
