## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Steve Stancil; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Steve Stancil was raised in Ball Ground, Georgia, in northern Cherokee County;  
3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, he graduated from Reinhardt College and went on to receive a BBA from the  
5 University of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Stancil served his country with honor and distinction in the United States  
7 Military, leaving the Air Force Reserve in 1977 as a Staff Sergeant; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he is a respected member of the business community as co-owner of Century  
9 21 Stancil Realty in Woodstock; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Stancil is a devoted husband and father and a valued member of the First  
11 Methodist Church of Canton; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Stancil has enjoyed a long and distinguished career in public service,  
13 serving as member of the Georgia House of Representatives from 1988 through 2001,  
14 including service as House Minority Leader and as a leading member of the House  
15 Appropriations Committee; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he sponsored many important legislative achievements, including a revision of  
17 the automobile ad valorem tax appraisal standards, legislation to allow transfer of  
18 development rights in order to protect greenspace, requirements for auditing and  
19 accountability in state grants, and creation of the Lake Allatoona Preservation Authority; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he has been recognized with presentation of the Legislative Service Award from  
21 the Georgia Municipal Association and the Association County Commissioners of Georgia

1 and has received numerous other service awards, particularly for his service to children and  
2 the developmentally disabled; and

3 WHEREAS, all the members of the General Assembly who were privileged to serve with  
4 Mr. Stancil knew him as a gentleman, a man of principle, a leader, and a true friend and  
5 highly respected him for his wisdom, integrity, courtesy, and good humor.

7 commends Steve Stancil for his distinguished career in public service and expresses  
8 appreciation for his many important contributions to the State of Georgia and its citizens.
