A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To increase state funded compensation for child care; to amend Chapter 1A of Title 20 of the
- 2 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Office of School Readiness, so as to
- 3 provide for the same rate of compensation for voluntary pre-kindergarten programs to
- 4 licensed child care learning centers and public schools; to provide for training and education
- 5 supplements in certain circumstances; to amend Article 9 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the
- 6 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- 7 Act, so as to increase the amount of state subsidies for child care for recipients of Temporary
- 8 Assistance to Needy Families; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

- 11 Chapter 1A of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Office of
- 12 School Readiness, is amended by inserting a new Code section to be designated Code
- 13 Section 20-1A-8 to read as follows:
- 14 "20-1A-8.
- 15 The Office of School Readiness shall provide the same rate of compensation for voluntary
- pre-kindergarten programs to licensed child care learning centers and public schools. When
- the pre-kindergarten program of a licensed child care learning center employs one or more
- lead teachers certificated by the Professional Standards Commission, the rate of
- 19 compensation for such a center shall include state training and education supplements paid
- 20 to certificated pre-kindergarten teachers in programs operated by public schools."
- SECTION 2.
- 22 Article 9 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 23 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Act, is amended by inserting a new Code section
- 24 to be designated Code Section 49-4-193 to read as follows:

- 1 "49-4-193.
- 2 In providing subsidies for child care for recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy
- Families, the department shall determine the amount of the subsidy for each child as an
- 4 amount equal to or greater than the seventy-fifth percentile rate as determined by the
- 5 department's most recent market rate survey for child care."

6 SECTION 3.

7 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
