A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Bremen, Georgia, on its 120th anniversary; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the city of Bremen, Georgia, in Haralson County was chartered on September
3 5, 1883, and will celebrate its 120th anniversary this year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mayor Sharon Sewell has announced that the city leaders are planning various
5 special events to recognize this milestone in the city's history; and
- 6 WHEREAS, currently the city is honoring the birthday with limited edition commemorative
7 lapel pins that feature the dates 1883 and 2003; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the city of Bremen has a long and distinguished history and its civic leaders
9 have exercised their responsibilities with integrity and diligence and contributed substantially
10 to the growth and development of this municipality and to the quality of life of its citizens;

- 12 WHEREAS, the role of municipal government in the lives of its citizens has undergone
13 profound changes since the early days of the republic and the adequacy and efficiency of
14 cities are measured by their success in recognizing future needs and planning appropriately
15 to ensure the safety, health, opportunity, and happiness of the people who inhabit them.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize the 120th anniversary of the city of Bremen, Georgia, and convey to its civic
18 leaders and citizens their congratulations on this momentous occasion in their proud history.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Mayor Sharon Sewell.
