#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the 2002 Clinch County High School football team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the 2002 Clinch County High School football team brought fame and honor to  
3 the team, the school, and the Homerville community and Clinch County by winning the state  
4 title for the first time since 1991 and the third time in 50 years; and
- 5 WHEREAS, these fabulous young athletes set a school record for the most wins in a season  
6 with their 15 wins and set a school record for most points in a season with a total of 553; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Panthers defeated their opponents by an average score of 36.8 to 8.1 during  
8 the season and defeated their playoff opponents by an average score of 43.4 to 8 which  
9 provides solid evidence of their exceptional ability; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Panthers proudly won the state Class A title by defeating Dooly County  
11 50-14 and the championship game was made sweeter by being the first at Panther Stadium;

- 13 WHEREAS, this outstanding record reflects the ability, motivation, and discipline of these  
14 fine players and the tremendous skill and experience of their coaching staff; and the  
15 memories of this championship season will be rightfully cherished by these young men  
16 forever!

18 commend the 2002 Clinch County Panthers as state Class A champions and convey to these
