A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To provide for the dedication of certain moneys for retention and use by the Commissioner

4	disposition of funds; to provide for the retention and use of moneys by the Commissioner;
5	to amend Article 3 of Chapter 7 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating
6	to use and application of pesticides, so as to provide for the retention and use of moneys by
7	the Commissioner; to amend Article 3 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia
8	Annotated, relating to equine diseases, so as to provide for the retention and use of moneys
9	by the Commissioner; to amend Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 4 of the Official Code of
10	Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to animal protection, so as to
11	provide for the retention and use of moneys by the Commissioner; to amend Chapter 45 of
12	Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons engaged in structural
13	pest control, so as to change certain provisions relating to civil penalties, negotiated
14	settlements, hearings and procedure, disposition of penalties, judicial review, and judgments;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 and application of pesticides, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget
- 8 Act,' moneys received by the Commissioner under this article may be retained by him or
- 9 her for the purpose of defraying the expenses of administration of this article, provided that
- any surplus at the end of the fiscal year shall be deposited into the state treasury."

SECTION 3.

- 12 Article 3 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to equine
- diseases, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget
- Act,' moneys received by the Commissioner under this article may be retained by him or

- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget
- Act,' moneys received by the Commissioner under this article may be retained by him or
- 26 her for the purpose of defraying the expenses of administration of this article, provided that
- any surplus at the end of the fiscal year shall be deposited into the state treasury."

28 SECTION 5.

- 29 Chapter 45 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons
- 30 engaged in structural pest control, is amended by striking subsection (c) of Code Section
- 31 43-45-24.1, relating to civil penalties, negotiated settlements, hearings and procedure,
- 32 disposition of penalties, judicial review, and judgments, and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 33 following:

1 "(c) All civil penalties recovered by the Commissioner as provided in this Code section

2 shall be paid into the state treasury Reserved."

3 SECTION 6.

- 4 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 5 "43-45-26.
- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45, the 'Budget
- Act,' moneys received by the Commissioner under this chapter may be retained by him or
- 8 her for the purpose of defraying the expenses of administration of this chapter, provided
- 9 that any surplus at the end of the fiscal year shall be deposited into the state treasury."

SECTION 7.

11 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
