A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-7-103 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 quarterly, monthly, and jeopardy returns, so as to increase the threshold for filing monthly
- 3 returns; to provide an effective date; to provide for applicability; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-7-103 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to quarterly,
- 8 monthly, and jeopardy returns, is amended by striking subsections (a) and (b) and inserting
- 9 in their place new subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- or less per month is required to file and remit payment to the department on or before the
- last day of the month following the end of the quarter.
- 13 (b) Every employer whose tax withheld or required to be withheld exceeds \$200.00
- 14 \$1,000.00 per month is required to file and remit payment to the department on or before
- the fifteenth day of the following month; provided, however, that the commissioner shall
- be authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to permit the filing of such returns on a
- 17 quarterly basis."
- 18 SECTION 2.
- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 20 without such approval and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning on or after
- 21 January 1, 2004.
- SECTION 3.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
