A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act making provisions for the Magistrate Court of Cobb County, approved  
2 March 24, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 4451), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
3 April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4751), so as to provide for the compensation of the chief  
4 magistrate of said court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act making provisions for the Magistrate Court of Cobb County, approved March 24,  
9 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 4451), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 25, 2002  
10 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4751), is amended by inserting at the end of Section 2 a new subsection (e)  
11 to read as follows:

12 "(e) The chief magistrate of the Magistrate Court of Cobb County shall receive an annual  
13 salary of \$99,564.74. Such salary shall be payable in equal monthly installments from the  
14 funds of Cobb County."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
17 without such approval.

18 **SECTION 3.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
