## A RESOLUTION

1 Creating the House Community Improvement District Study Committee; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the creation of community improvement districts is authorized under Article IX,  
4 Section VII, of the Constitution; and

5 WHEREAS, there continues to be an apparent underutilization of this method of community  
6 improvement and redevelopment; and

7 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to undertake a comprehensive study of these districts to  
8 determine what actions the General Assembly can take to encourage the creation of  
9 additional community improvement districts.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
11 there is created the House Community Improvement District Study Committee to be  
12 composed of five members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker  
13 of the House of Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee  
14 as chairperson of the committee. The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions,  
16 needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action  
17 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may  
18 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or  
19 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and  
20 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The members of the committee  
21 shall receive the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of  
22 Georgia Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by  
23 any member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.  
24 The funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from the funds

1 appropriated to the House of Representatives. In the event the committee makes a report of  
2 its findings and recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such  
3 report shall be made on or before December 1, 2003. The committee shall stand abolished  
4 on December 1, 2003.
