## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elementary and secondary education, so as to exempt teachers desiring to transfer to Georgia
- 3 from other states from the Praxis examinations in certain circumstances; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and
- 8 secondary education, is amended by inserting a new Code section to be designated Code
- 9 Section 20-2-989.2 to read as follows:
- 10 "20-2-989.2.
- 11 The commission shall not require a teacher from another state desiring to transfer to this
- state to take the Praxis examinations for certification if such teacher:
- 13 (1) Is at that time employed in a state that has reciprocal certification or licensing with
- this state;
- 15 (2) Is at that time employed by a school system that is regionally accredited by the
- 16 Southern Association of Colleges and Schools;
- 17 (3) Has a minimum of five consecutive years of satisfactory annual performance
- 18 evaluations; and
- 19 (4) Has met all the course requirements for regional accreditation."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
