A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Aud Lee Stepp; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on February 10, 2003, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the tragic and untimely passing of Aud Lee Stepp; and

4 WHEREAS, this exceptional individual exhibited outstanding leadership and meticulous
5 attention to detail in all of his life including his service as Chairman of the Fannin County
6 Commission, as Chairman of the Fannin County Hospital Authority, as a member of the
7 Fannin County Board of Education, as Mayor of McCaysville, as a member of the
8 McCaysville City Council, and as a member of the McCaysville Board of Education; and

9 WHEREAS, his unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
10 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens

16 the members of this body express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Aud
17 Lee Stepp.
