A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Aubrey E. Fallin; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Aubrey E. Fallin, a native Georgian, has long been recognized as an outstanding
3 citizen and patriot; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on August 23, 1925, in Coolidge, Thomas County, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, from October 1943 until August 1946, he served with the 5th Marine Division,
6 28th Regiment, the regiment that raised the American flag on Iwo Jima; and
- 7 WHEREAS, during the 36-day Iwo Jima campaign, 6,821 Americans were killed and 20,000
8 were wounded; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in 1947, following his service with the Marines, he began a successful business
10 career in the area of sales and management; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he is a Mason, a Shriner, and a member of the First Baptist Church in Douglas,
12 Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he and his lovely wife, Velma Tryan Fallin, have been married for 56 years and
14 have raised three children: a daughter, Linda, and two sons, Kenneth and Ted; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the contributions of this outstanding
16 citizen be properly recognized.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Aubrey E. Fallin for his dedicated and unselfish service to his country, his state,
19 and his community and convey to him their respect and appreciation.
