A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Bob Walling; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on February 13, 2003, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the tragic and untimely passing of Bob Walling; and

4 WHEREAS, this exceptional individual exhibited outstanding leadership and commitment
5 to public service in all of his life including his service as a superior court judge, as a member
6 of the General Assembly, as county attorney for DeKalb County, as a professor, and as an
7 attorney; and

8 WHEREAS, his unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
9 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens
10 of his community and state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
11 associates; and

12 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, kind, and devoted family man leaves an
13 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Bob Walling.
