## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Louise Boyce as the Distinguished Senior Georgian for 2003; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Louise Boyce of Athens, Georgia, was named the Distinguished Senior  
4 Georgian for 2003 by the Georgia Council on Aging in recognition of her exemplary service  
5 to her community and state and the positive role model she represents for all Georgians; and

6 WHEREAS, she was born on June 11, 1912, in Due West, South Carolina, graduated from  
7 Agnes Scott College in 1934, received a master's in education from Florida State University,  
8 and taught school for many years in South Carolina, Florida, and Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, at the remarkable age of 90, she continues to serve as a full-time volunteer with  
10 Meals on Wheels five days a week, Recording for the Blind four days a week, and the Athens  
11 Regional Medical Center at least once a week; and

12 WHEREAS, she was named Retired Educator of the Year by the Athens Area Retired  
13 Educators Association and is very involved with the American Association of University  
14 Women and Central Presbyterian Church of Athens; and

15 WHEREAS, she has received numerous professional, academic, and community service  
16 awards and citations including the Outstanding Alumna award from Agnes Scott College for  
17 her extraordinary leadership, dedication, and community service; and

18 WHEREAS, Senior Week at the capitol has been established to recognize the valuable  
19 contributions older Georgians make to our state and will be observed March 3-7, 2003.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body recognize and commend Louise Boyce as the Distinguished Senior  
22 Georgian for 2003 and convey to her their admiration, respect, and best wishes.
