A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Tina Frese; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Tina Frese is widely recognized throughout the state as the personification of
3 excellence in education; and

4 WHEREAS, this highly respected teacher in the Thomasville City school system has served
5 with honor and distinction as a professional educator at Harper Elementary School; and

6 WHEREAS, she believes that her role as a fourth grade teacher is to act as an instrument of
7 inspiration and enthusiasm to her pupils and to create a positive learning environment
8 through the encouragement of competitive instincts in her students; and

9 WHEREAS, in recognition of her outstanding dedication to academic achievement, she has
10 been awarded National Board Certification and is the first educator in her school system to
11 receive such certification; and

12 WHEREAS, she is a shining example of the important impact that the efforts of individual
13 classroom teachers are making on the quality of education received by the children of this
14 state and it is abundantly fitting and proper that her superlative accomplishments be
15 recognized appropriately.

18 contributions on behalf of education in Georgia and for the positive influence she has had
