

House Resolution 356

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to
 2 provide by general law for a motor vehicle emissions fund and provide for allocations and
 3 dedication of certain revenue to such fund; to provide that moneys paid into such fund shall
 4 not lapse; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and
 5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI is amended by adding a new subparagraph (m) to read
 9 as follows:

10 "(m) The General Assembly is authorized to provide by general law for the creation of
 11 a motor vehicle emissions fund from which funds shall be disbursed for the support of
 12 motor vehicle emissions reduction programs; for allocation and dedication of revenue from
 13 fees for certificates for vehicles passing remote sensing technology emissions inspections;
 14 that moneys paid into the fund shall not lapse, the provisions of Article III, Section IX,
 15 Paragraph IV(c) notwithstanding; and for any matters relating to the purpose or provisions
 16 of this subparagraph."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
 19 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
 20 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

21 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to authorize the General Assembly
 22 to provide by general law for the creation of a motor vehicle emissions fund
 23 () NO from which funds shall be disbursed for the support of motor vehicle
 emissions reduction programs; for allocation and dedication of revenue
 from fees for certificates for vehicles passing remote sensing technology
 emissions inspections; and that moneys paid into the fund shall not lapse?"

- 1 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 2 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 3 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 4 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
