A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, periods of adjournment and
4 reconvening for the remainder of this 2003 regular session of the General Assembly shall be
5 as follows:

6 (1) The General Assembly shall adjourn at the conclusion of the legislative day on
7 Thursday, March 6, the 26th legislative day of the session;

8 (2) The General Assembly shall reconvene on Monday, March 24th, the 27th legislative
9 day of the session;

10 (3) The General Assembly shall adjourn at the conclusion of the legislative day on
11 Thursday, March 27, the 30th legislative day of the session;

12 (4) The General Assembly shall reconvene on Monday, March 31, the 31st legislative day
13 of the session;

14 (5) The General Assembly shall adjourn at the conclusion of the legislative day on
15 Thursday, April 3, the 34th day of the legislative session;

16 (6) The General Assembly shall reconvene on Monday, April 7, the 35th day of the
17 legislative session;

18 (7) The General Assembly shall adjourn at the conclusion of the legislative day on
19 Thursday, April 10, the 38th day of the legislative session;

20 (8) The General Assembly shall reconvene on Monday, April 14, the 39th day of the
21 legislative session and again adjourn at the conclusion of that legislative day; and

22 (9) The General Assembly shall reconvene on Wednesday, April 16, the 40th and final day
23 of the legislative session.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the hour for closing and convening the Senate on each
25 such day shall be as ordered by the Senate; and the hour for closing and convening the House
26 on each such day shall be as ordered by the House.
