A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act approved March 13, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978, p. 3677), as amended by an Act  
2 approved April 6, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 3309), which Act as so amended provided for a  
3 board of registration and elections in counties having a population of not less than 350,000  
4 and not more than 500,000 according to the decennial census of 1970 or any future such  
5 census; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 The following Act is repealed in its entirety: an Act approved March 13, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978,  
9 p. 3677), as amended by an Act approved April 6, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 3309), which Act  
10 as so amended provided for a board of registration and elections in counties having a  
11 population of not less than 350,000 and not more than 500,000 according to the decennial  
12 census of 1970 or any future such census.

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
15 without such approval.

16 **SECTION 3.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
