A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the control of signs and signals along public roads, so as to change provisions
- 3 relating to the penalty for violations; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 7 control of signs and signals along public roads, is amended by striking Code Section 32-6-91,
- 8 relating to the penalty for erecting or maintaining a sign without a permit, and inserting in
- 9 lieu thereof the following:
- 10 "32-6-91.

- Any person who erects or maintains any sign for which a permit is required by this part
- without a valid permit or renewal of such permit issued by the department shall be guilty
- of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of \$500.00. Each day or fraction thereof
- during which a sign is unlawfully maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The
- 15 commissioner and officials or employees of said department designated by the
- 16 commissioner are authorized to take such actions as may be necessary or appropriate to
- 17 procure the prosecution and conviction of any person, firm, or corporation violating this
- 18 Code section."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 Said article is further amended by striking Code Section 32-6-92, relating to the penalty for
- 21 the maintenance of an unauthorized sign, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 22 "32-6-92.
- Any person who maintains any sign not authorized by this part and which was not lawfully
- in existence on October 6, 1971, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished
- by a fine of \$500.00. Each day or fraction thereof during which a sign is unlawfully

1 maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The commissioner and officials or

- 2 employees of the department designated by the commissioner are authorized to take such
- 3 actions as may be necessary or appropriate to procure the prosecution and conviction of
- 4 any person, firm, or corporation violating this Code section."

5 SECTION 3.

6 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
