A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Phillip Thomas Lee; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Phillip Thomas Lee, a member of Boy Scout Troop 24 in Cartersville, Georgia,
3 will receive the Eagle Scout Award, the highest rank in scouting, on March 30, 2003; and

4 WHEREAS, a candidate for this premier rank must complete a rigorous program of training,
5 demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques, pass his Eagle Board of Review,
6 and complete a substantial community service project; and

7 WHEREAS, very few young men in scouting ever reach this lofty level of achievement and
8 the attainment of the rank of Eagle indicates that a Scout has developed leadership ability,
9 self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be of
10 immense benefit throughout his life; and

11 WHEREAS, this outstanding Scout has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
12 principles of honesty, fairness, and service to the community and has consistently conducted
13 himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, he has brought honor to himself, his parents,
15 Gene and Nanci Lee, and continued a family tradition that includes his father, uncles, and his
16 much admired older brother, Stephen.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 this body commends Phillip Thomas Lee on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and conveys
19 to him their congratulations and best wishes in his future pursuits.
