A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 13, 2003, as "Disabilities Day at the Capitol" and recognizing the
- 2 outstanding efforts and support that advocacy organizations around the state provide to
- 3 individuals with disabilities, their families, and the greater community at large to enhance
- 4 the quality of life for people with disabilities; and for other purposes.
- 5 WHEREAS, in the State of Georgia there are over 1.4 million people over age five with
- 6 disabilities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, people with disabilities and their families want to be part of the community but
- 8 often need opportunities for real homes, real jobs, real learning experiences, and real choices
- 9 in their lives; and
- 10 WHEREAS, people with disabilities want to live, learn, work, and play in their communities
- 11 first; and
- 12 WHEREAS, people with disabilities and their families value partnership and collaboration
- 13 with policymakers statewide in order to create systematic change and a society that values
- 14 all of its citizens; and
- 15 WHEREAS, there is a need for opportunities for individuals with disabilities and their
- 16 families to address public policy issues such as the "Unlock the Waiting Lists" campaign,
- 17 accessible housing, supported employment, and long-term care.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 19 the members of this body recognize March 13, 2003, as "Disabilities Day at the Capitol" in
- 20 recognition of advocates, individuals with disabilities, and their family members to create
- 21 communities where individuals may live to their fullest potential by sponsoring activities that
- promote the independence, productivity, integration, and inclusion of people with disabilities.
