9 law with his father, Edgar Duskin Kenyon, before his appointment to the bench in 1965; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a respected judge who was dedicated to justice and merciful when appropriate,
11 he continued to provide valuable leadership to his community after his retirement, advocating
12 for the protection of Lake Lanier and other environmental issues; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he and his beloved wife of 60 years, Lois Snyder Kenyon, reared a fine family
14 of four daughters and enjoyed spending time with their three cherished grandchildren.
