A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., and recognizing April 4, 2003, as a day of
2 commemorating their contributions to the College Park, Georgia, community; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., was founded on the campus of Indiana
5 University in Bloomington, Indiana, on January 5, 1911, by ten astute and visionary
6 gentlemen; and

7 WHEREAS, the College Park, Georgia, Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.,
8 was founded on April 4, 1981; and

9 WHEREAS, five objectives serve as a blueprint for their goal of excellence: to unite college
10 men of culture, patriotism, and honor in bonds of fraternity; to encourage honorable
11 achievement in every field of human endeavor; to promote the spiritual, social, intellectual,
12 and moral welfare of members; to assist the aims and purposes of colleges and universities;
13 and to inspire to service in the public interest; and

14 WHEREAS, these objectives are evidenced in the organization of the Kappa Scholarship
15 Endowment Fund; Student of the Year Pageant; food, blood, and voter registration drives;
16 Adopt-A-Highway Program; and yearly participation in programs for the Women's Shelter
17 of College Park, Georgia. On a national level, their efforts are evidenced in the Guide Right
18 and Prostate Cancer Awareness Programs.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize April 4, 2003, as College Park Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity,
21 Inc., Recognition Day in commendation of the organization for its contributions to the
